Face of Winter is an homage to Miller, featuring current extreme skiers plus many looks back at old film footage and repeatedly mentioning his famous skiing quotation, "If you don't do it this year, you'll be one year older when you do."

The Backcountry Film Festival to coming to Asheville on Thursday, December 6th at Sierra Nevada Brewing. This festival is produced each year by the Winter Wildlands Alliance, a nonprofit organization working nationally to promote and preserve winter wildlands and quality human-powered snowsports on public lands.

A collection of nine short films, 5-20 minutes long capture the spirit of winter, adventure, youth outdoors, and ski culture — you'll find it all in this award-winning lineup.
