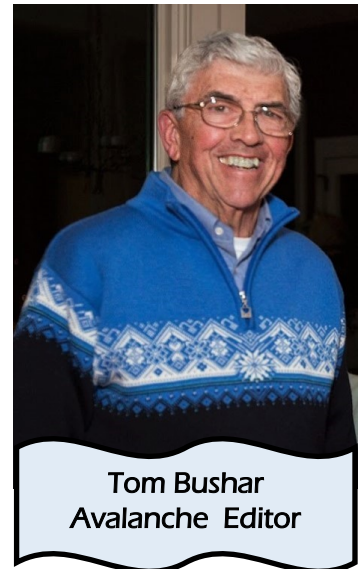
Newsletter Editor's Notes

You don't want to be left behind. It's way more fun to ski with people you know and to make new friends while you're at it. After all, you can't have too many friends!

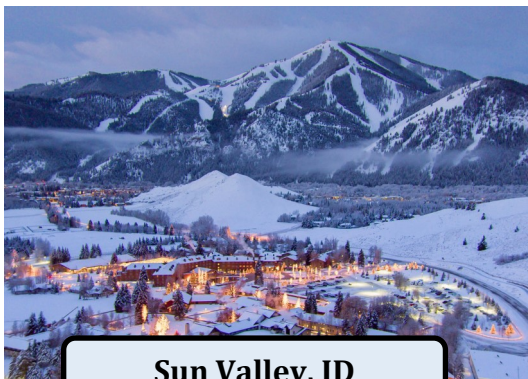
